#### Date: April 30, 2016

- HOURS: Tournament Hours 7AM to 3PM (Launch from 5AM / Weigh In by 3 PM)
- FIELD: 125 Boat Limit (Any size boat may compete)
- LIMITS: 5 Largest Catfish Limit (per boat) determines winners.
- ENTRY FEE: \$75 per boat (early bird) or \$90 per boat at the landing the morning of the Tournament. All early entry forms must be mailed to Berkeley County Rescue Squad with entry fee.
  - Confirmations will be mailed.
- All boats must launch and weigh in at William Dennis Boat Landing (across the river from Gilligan's) SITE: in Moncks Corner, SC (NO TRAILERING)
- PRIZES: Cash Prizes for Teams 1 through 10 (based on 125 boat field)
- RULES: Fish must be caught on rod & reel
  - No Professional Guides permitted to fish tournament
  - Fishing Area: Any area between the sanctuary behind Pinopolis Dam on the Cooper River
  - All decisions of the Tournament Committee are final
  - All teams (boats) will be assigned a number according to registration
  - All prize winners subject to polygraph test
  - Must observe NO WAKE zones.

The Catfish Committee reserves the right to reject any application or any person from participating in the tournament.
