SITE: All boats must launch and weigh in at **William Dennis Boat Landing** (across the river from Gilligan's) in Moncks Corner, SC (**NO TRAILERING**)

PRIZES: Cash Prizes for Teams 1 through 10 (based on 125 boat field)

RULES: Fish must be caught on rod & reel

No Professional Guides permitted to fish tournament

Fishing Area: Any area between the sanctuary behind Pinopolis Dam on the Cooper River

Must observe **NO WAKE** zones.
